NOTICE is given that the audit of accounts of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Essex and the Chief Constable of Essex for the year ended 31 March 2013 has been concluded and an unqualified audit opinion was issued on 30 September 2013.

Section 14 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 provides that any relevant local government elector shall be entitled:

- b) to require a copy of the statement or any report to be delivered to him on payment of a reasonable sum for each copy.
