

During 2012/13 the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) of Essex replaced the Essex Police Authority. For 2012/13 there is a Statement of Accounts for the PCC and a separate Statement of Accounts for the Chief Constable.

Although the Chief Constable has day to day control over most of the PCC's assets as well as daily direction and control over all police officers and the great majority of police staff, the level of financial and strategic control held by the PCC means that on balance, transactions, benefits and liabilities sit within the accounts of the PCC and there are no transactions or balances within the Chief Constable's accounts. This is in accordance with the principles of International Accounting Standard 18 (Revenue Recognition).
